When entering the dump please be sure to show the attendant your pass card.

Persons without a current member card are obligated to pay the rates posted on the entrance sign.

Do not pitch loose pieces of paper and garbage over the top. Garbage must be bagged or boxed. Poly grocery store bags are not acceptable and are one of the main contributors of litter around the site. Dump only during dump hours, persons dumping outside the compound can be fined. This site can only accept household garbage and recyclables. Waste from building demolition not accepted by this site. Do not bring hazardous materials, chemicals, paints, engine oils, boats and tires.

Fridges and freezers must be tagged (coolant removed) with doors and lids removed. Units that are not tagged have a \$55 charge paid to the attendant. Do not unload unless the tag and or fee is provided. **MICROWAVES** - \$8.00 charge paid to the attendant.

The attendant can accept exact cash or cheques only.

2017 - ALL Cardboard must be flat and bundled for recycling. It will be accepted by Jonathan and put into the storage building next to the gate. We will be hauling it to Emo where Cloverleaf will bale it and send off for recycling.

We received a few comments last season regarding accessibility to our dump site, key requests, increased hour frequency, etc. The CPRA Board is RESPONSIBLE for our dump site; it must be managed, and maintained according to strict MNR regulations. It's not perfect - but darn good in comparison to other communities - with longer distances, less frequency and higher costs, to access their dump. We are very fortunate to have our site and we need to maintain it accordingly.

Please DO NOT leave your trash outside the fence, nor toss it over the gate, when the gates are locked; For those times of need, reach out to one of the local camps, and drop your trash with them, keeping in mind - the camps ARE NOT trash collection businesses on a regular basis. They do not mind helping out in a pinch, but please do not take advantage of this generosity.

Long and short, our dump is maintained by donations of money, and donations of time by our volunteers both contributed by our little community. To all of you donating fees, Thank you! To all of you volunteering, Thank you! It takes all of us, to keep our dump operational today and in the future.

We would like to thank Sam Hayes and Hunter Adams for brushing our walking trails. If you have never been down them before, you should try it - its a beautiful walk! We also need to thank Frank Sheppard for all his hard work with the Fire hall - It is a HUGE responsibility and mountains of paperwork to keep our facility and equipment up to date.
